Introduction

HDR UK is seeking to appoint an experienced finance professional to its Audit and Risk committee. They will be the single experienced finance voice on the committee and within the wider governance structure.

About the Committee

The Audit and Risk committee assists the Board in meeting its responsibilities in respect of financial reporting, ensuring that resources of the organisation are used effectively and aligned with the mission of the organisation: to unite the UK's health data to make discoveries that improve people's lives. The committee provides a channel of communication between HDR UK's auditors and the Board. It is there to assist the Institute Director and Chair of the Board to create an environment in which accounting and information systems can operate effectively, and to assist all Board members by ensuring compliance with their statutory duties and responsibilities.

Role

The successful candidate will provide finance expertise and experience to the committee and the wider governance structure. Attendance is required at a minimum of 3 meetings per year, with additional time commitment to review papers and be available as requested to provide advice to the business.

The role is unremunerated but reasonable expenses that comply with our expenses policy will be paid.

Requirements

The successful candidate will have:

- Chartered Accountant status
- Experience of a wide range of differing industries and/or sectors
- Experience in or advising rapidly growing businesses or in a rapidly growing industry
- The ability to support the organisation flexibly
- Experience of the scrutiny placed on public-fronting industries
- The ability to act as a critical friend, with the knowledge to make sound judgement and recommendations.
