What is sensitive data?

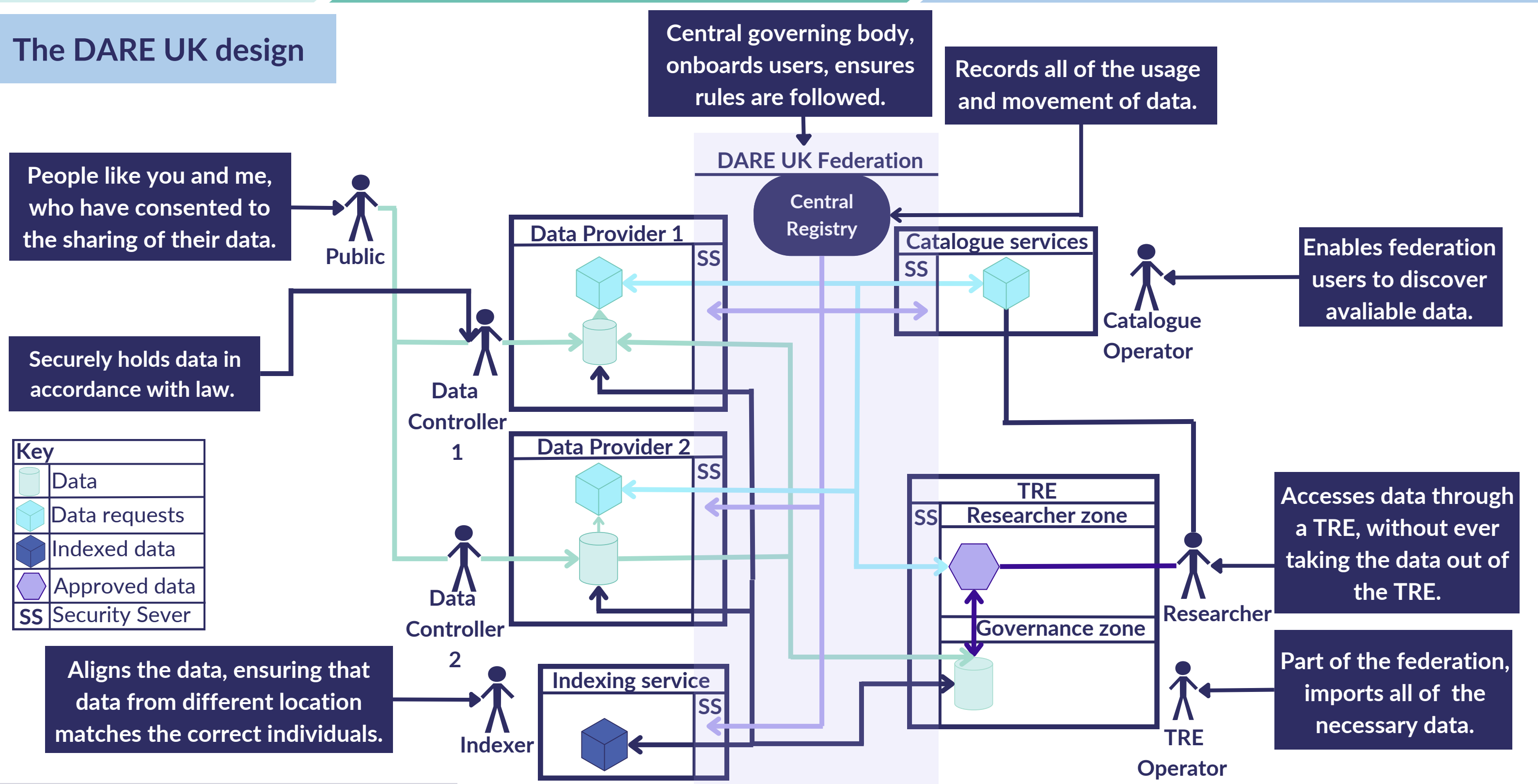
- Sensitive data:** information that must be kept confidential, e.g. **health, crime, and ethnicity** information.
- It is collected through interactions with public services or through participation in clinical trials and surveys.

What is the Problem with sensitive data research?

- Most sensitive data is held in TREs (Trusted Research Environments), secure computer systems guarded by **laws and regulations**.
- TREs are all unique in the type of data they store and the way they store it.
 - This makes linking their data **complex and difficult**.

What is DARE UK'S solution?

- DARE UK has designed a **secure, standardised and centrally governed** federation, that streamlines the linking of TRE data.
- This supports **cross-domain research** (research across multiple areas, such as health, the environment and education).



How can DARE UK benefit you?

Harness the power of research

Linking data allows researchers to tackle the issues that matter to us most, like pandemic preparedness, climate change, and NHS.

Reduce barriers to research

Streamlining the research process means that research findings can improve our lives at a **faster** rate.

Transparent and accessible research

Through the central registry we can see when, where and by whom our research is being used.
